New licence application - Shell Wolverhampton, Birmingham Road, Wolverhampton, WV2 3LH

Thank-you for your email dated 02/08/2017 in reference to the above premises' new licence application.

On behalf of Public Health I would like to make representation under the licensing objectives of:

- · Prevention of crime and disorder
- · Prevention of public nuisance
- Public safety

The application has failed to reassure me that the licencing objectives will be adequately promoted.

I have particular concern around the request to supply alcohol 24/7. The premises sit between two CIZs and is very close to the City Centre. Supplying alcohol unreservedly is very likely to exacerbate issues of street drinking, ASB and violence.

I have been liaising with Police colleagues in the mediation with the applicant. The conditions proposed by the Police are acceptable by Public Health and should these be agreed by the applicant I will withdraw this representation.
