**Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information)
(England) Regulations 2012
Agreement of Scrutiny Board Chair under Regulation 10**

Under these Regulations the Council is required to give 28 days notice of a key decision. If the Council is not able to give the required notice it must obtain the agreement of the Chair of the Scrutiny Board, and publish a copy of that notice (Regulation 10). Urgent?	Yes
Reason for Urgency:	The legal process required to convert the Gating Orders to Public Space Protection Orders needs completion by 1 October 2017 in line with the Anti-social Behaviour, Police and Crime Act. Failure to do so would mean the gates on the highway would become illegal obstructions and could be removed. A decision by Cabinet on 13 September leaves insufficient time to achieve the deadline.
