Decisions made under this provision will be reported to the next available meeting of the Committee. 				
Background to Decision	The operating budget for 2022/23 has been developed to reflect the objectives and priorities set out in the Fund's Corporate Plan, produced in response to growing service demand, changing regulatory requirements and governance standards, together with the Fund's own ongoing service transformation. All budgets have been subject to thorough review in context of the emerging programme of work required by the Fund, tested for adequacy and adjusted where appropriate.				
	LGPS regulations allow for the costs of administering the Pension Fund to be charged to the Pension Fund; costs do not flow directly to the Administering Authority or any other participating employers. The actuary makes provision in the triennial Actuarial Valuation for Fund administration and governance costs, with investment return targets and monitoring established net of investment management costs.				
	Regular monitoring of the operating budget, including the preparation of a forecast outturn, will be undertaken throughout the year, and reported to Pensions Committee at quarterly intervals.
