

**5.1.10(a) Dishonesty**

*First offence* – will normally revoke or refuse to renew. A new licence will not normally be granted for 5 years following the date of conviction or expiry of a prison sentence. **CLEAR 18/11/2002**

**5.1.3(a) Major Traffic Offences (Other than drink driving and drug offences)**

*First offence* – will normally revoke or refuse to renew. A new licence will not normally be granted for 5 years following the expiration of the disqualification period or if not disqualified 5 years from the date of conviction. **CLEAR 02/03/2008**
