Having reviewed the evidence put forward by trading standards, Public Health supports the request to review the premises. The premises is located within an area which is cause for concern when viewing alcohol related harm. The area has concerning levels of individuals in treatment for alcohol dependence, high levels of alcohol related hospital admissions and concerning levels of alcohol related violence.

Whilst the review request has come as a result of the applicant dealing in illicit tobacco, not alcohol, as a Responsible Authority we are of the view a licence holder within an area suffering this level of alcohol related harm should be exemplar in their management and execution of licensable activities.
