**Burleigh Mini Market – review of premises licence**

Thank-you for your email dated 22/08/2018 in reference to the request made by Trading Standards to review the premises licence for Burleigh Mini Market.

I have reviewed the documentation put forward by Trading Standards and would support the request to review the premises licence under the licensing objective of:

- The prevention of crime and disorder

Public Health have very serious concerns regarding the significant amount of illicit tobacco seized on 21 May 2018. As a Responsible Authority we would expect any business licensed to sell alcohol to act responsibly at all times and promote the key objectives of the Licensing Act 2003. Public Health is not reassured that the business is operating in adherence to the Licensing Act and therefore supports Trading Standards request to the review the current licence.
