# Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

## General Licensing Objectives:

The types of regulated entertainments proposed re-instate and then enhance the normal pub entertainments that were previously unregulated, with the benefit to enhance the local facilities for social entertainment and reduce the focus on alcohol;  
No new steps have been identified by my risk assessment in relation to the four licensing objectives, except as below.

## Prevention of Crime & Disorder:

Providing a 60 minute extension to opening hours after the end of the sale of alcohol will promote this objective as the last drink will be consumed less quickly, with access to the pubs toilet facilities;  
Application made to the local pub watch scheme.

## Public Safety:

My risk assessment identifies no other risk or crowding  
During times of regulated entertainment the maximum occupancy for the premises will be 60 persons.

## Prevention of Public Nuisance:

All windows and doors will be kept closed during times of regulated entertainment.

## Protection of Children from harm:

The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply;  
No unusual risks of harm to children have been identified.
