The Deputy Monitoring Officer presented a report, which set out the recommendations of the Special Advisory Group concerning the Annual Review of the Council's Constitution for 2009/10 together with other amendments which will complete the review for 2009/10.

It was noted that the Working Copy of the Constitution could be viewed either via the Monitoring Officer or in the Members' Room. It was further noted that the comprehensive review of the Constitution would not be completed in time for approval at Annual Council.
