Declarations of Interest

Exclusion of Press and Public

40 Resolved:-

That, in accordance with Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the press and public be excluded from consideration of the items of business in Part II of the Agenda, on the grounds that in view of the nature of the business to be transacted or the nature of the proceedings, exempt information falling within paragraph 7a of Schedule 12A to the Act (information presented to a Standards Committee under section 58 of the local Government Act 2000) is likely to be disclosed.

Complaint under the Members' Code of Conduct (Appendix 22)

A report was presented which informed the Sub-Committee of a complaint, received by the Council's Monitoring Officer, that a Member of the Council had failed to follow the Members' Code of Conduct. It was the role of this Sub-Committee to decide whether any action should be taken in connection with the complaint and, if so, the nature of the action. The report outlined the options available to the members in this respect.

Having carefully considered the complaint, the Sub-Committee:-
