Recommendation for action or decision:

The Licensing Sub-Committee is requested to consider this application to transfer the premises licence for The International Minimarket and vary the Designated Premises Supervisor.

1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 To submit for consideration by the Sub-Committee an application to transfer the premises licence and vary the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) for The International Minimarket.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 An application was received from Licenced Trade Legal Services Limited, on behalf of Mr Pavel Slavov Hristov to transfer the premises licence and vary the Designated Premises Supervisor.
- 2.2 The applications were made on 14 September 2015 and received and accepted by Wolverhampton City Council as properly made applications. A copy of the transfer and vary DPS application are attached at Appendix 1 and Appendix 2.
- 2.3 The Police, have been consulted on these applications as a responsible authority.
- 2.4 The Police have made relevant representations and are objecting to these applications. A copy of their formal representation is attached at Appendix 3.
- 2.5 The premises are situated in the Whitmore Reans ward and a location plan is attached at Appendix 4.
- 2.6 A copy of the premises licence for The International Minimarket is attached at Appendix 5.
- 2.7 The applicant, their representative, and West Midlands Police have been invited to attend the hearing.

3.0 Legal Implications

- 3.1 All applications shall be determined in accordance with the four licensing objectives namely:
 - The prevention of crime and disorder;
 - Public safety:
 - The prevention of public nuisance;
 - The protection of children from harm.

Section 42 of the Licensing Act 2003 provides that any person meeting the requirements under this section may apply to the licensing authority for transfer of a premises licence to him.

An application made under s42 must be accompanied by the premises licence or, if that is not practicable, a statement of the reasons for the failure to provide the licence.

The Chief Officer of Police must be given notice of the application and where, following notice, the Chief Officer is satisfied that the exceptional circumstances of the case are such that granting the application would undermine the crime prevention objective he must give notice to the Licensing Authority stating the reasons he is so satisfied.

Section 44 of the 2003 Act provides that were notice is given to the Licensing Authority (and not withdrawn) the authority must hold a hearing and having regard to the notice, reject the application if it considers it appropriate for the promotion of the crime prevention objective.

Section 37 of the Licensing Act 2003 may apply to vary the licence to specify the proposed person as the designated premises supervisor.

Section 39 of the 2003 Act provides applications to vary a person specified as a designated premises supervisor may only be rejected if it is considered necessary for the promotion of the crime and disorder objective.

Regard shall be had to guidance issued by the Secretary of State under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 and Wolverhampton City Council's Licensing Policy Statement. [SH/25092015/I]

4.0 Financial Implications

4.1 The Licensing Committee agreed fees and charges for this function on 21st January 2015. The fees are based on a cost recovery basis. The fee for the application of a transfer is £23.00 and the fee for a vary DPS is £23.00; both are non-refundable. [TK/09012015/H]

I wish to raise objections to these applications on behalf of the Chief officer of Police for the West Midlands, under the prevention of crime licensing objective.



Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions:
- (2) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:-
 - (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or ...
 - (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
- (3) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- **4.** (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Mandatory Licensing Condition banning the sale of alcohol below the cost of VAT and duty: 2014

- 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1—
 - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979(6);
 - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula $P = D + (D \times V)$

where-

- (i) P is the permitted price,
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iv) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence:
- (d)"relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e)"value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994(7).
- 3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- **4.** (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

General

Nothing beyond existing health & safety/ fire safety etc. requirements.

The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises will have correct specification, internal and external CCTV, recordings of which will be retained for thirty one days.

There is existing external frontage roller shutters and also a security metal gate at the rear of the premises, which will be fully alarmed. including a panic alarm button facility.

The personal licence holder shall ensure that any staff involved in the sale of alcohol are fully trained on their responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003 including any changes of legislation and all staff will be trained in the usage and chronicled storage of CCTV. All written training records will be available on site for inspection at any time.

Public safety

Also internal and external CCTV etc.

Premises will have fully maintained fire fighting equipment on site with a maintenance contract along with emergency lighting and smoke detectors.

The prevention of public nuisance

Internal and particularly any external CCTV, is a proven deterrent in terms of any anti-social activities in respect of the outlet's frontage and the immediate vicinity of the premises. The applicant and his staff will at all times be vigilant in relation to any litter issues.

The protection of children from harm

Also internal and external CCTV etc.

Layout of shop gives consideration to the prevention of children's access to alcohol and any alcohol displayed will not be obstructed from the view of the sales assistants. Also premises will operate a proof of age scheme via acceptable forms of identification and incorporating 'the challenge 21' system.

A sales refusal book will be fully maintained and available for inspection at any time.
