Good Afternoon all

At 1500 hrs on 01/08/17 PC 5192 Bevan and PC 1096 Morris attended the news agents School St (WV507) following an extremely intoxicated male who had attended the location and purchased 2 bottles of white lightening. This was confirmed by the shop and cctv shows the member of staff leaving the counter to recover the alcohol from the shelf for the intoxicated male. Staff have then proceeded to continue to sell alcohol to other intoxicated males who have sat outside the shop causing asb.

The manager was not present at the time of the sale and Danny [REDACTED] was the only person present.

Later the manager Baljit Singh [REDACTED] returned. A conversation was had around a number of problems being.....

Baljit is not aware of the licence conditions, although he has a licence summary displayed.

He was not able to download the cctv so this was recorded on PC 5192 Bevans mobile device of the sale of alcohol.

He is the main cause of asb outside the shop and on school street due to the single sale of cans to the locals.

Finally there was a concern for H&S regarding the large quantity of stock the shop has on the stairs. This has been evidenced on PC 5192 Bevans mobility device.

I have tried to add this to the inn keeper however it keeps denying me access.

I am happy to carry out the necessary work but was hoping for some guidance on where I could go with this?
