Lisa Potts GM was a former nursery teacher who valiantly put herself in harms way to protect children in her care from a machete wielding attacker at St. Luke's Primary School in Blakenhall in 1996. Lisa, was just 21 years old at the time and sustained severe injuries during the incident.

Lisa Potts GM continues to stay in contact with many of the children who were involved in the event in 1996.

The Leader of the Council proposed the recommendation, the Leader of the Opposition Group, Councillor Wendy Thompson seconded the recommendation and paid tribute to the bravery of Lisa Potts GM.
