# This follows:-

The seizure on the 15 February 2019, of 9860 illegal cigarettes sticks (493 packets of 20), and 969 Sildenafil Citrate tablets, a pharmacy controlled drug, discovered on the premises of K S News and Off Licence, 120 Oxford Street, Bilston, Wolverhampton.

I have attached a copy of the Review Notice, seizure log and photographs. This notice outlines the reasons why this Service is asking for a review. The Review Notice will also be served on the Licensing Authority, as well as the other responsible authorities.

with a Tobacco search dog. On this occasion 9860 cloarette sticks, equivalent to 403
packs were discovered behind the counter, and in a store room.
n addition, 969 Sildenafil Citrate 100mg tablets were discovered in blister packs
behind the counter. Although not a classified drug under the Misuse of Drugs Act

gency. Pharmacy medicines such as Sildenafil Citrate may only be legally sold or
upplied to the public through registered pharmacy premises, by or under the
upervision of a pharmacist. KS News has not been given authorisation to sell such

his address as \_\_\_\_\_\_. The tobacco products were suspected of being counterfeit or non duty paid and were subsequently seized.

A traders notice was left with \_\_\_\_\_\_, He was advised during the inspection that it was a criminal offence to possess, supply or sell counterfeit products or illicit tobacco products where those goods are marked as duty free or where UK duty has not been paid on those goods.

The seized goods included a large number of cigarettes known as 'foreign cheap whites', e.g. FEST, Minsk, and NZ which are foreign brands brought into the UK illegally specifically to be sold on the black market. English branded tobacco products such as KENT, that bore foreign warnings and labelling were seized because they breached UK regulations on packaging and labelling and were non UK DUTY paid. They were manufactured for other domestic markets. Investigations are ongoing as to wherther some of the tobacco products are counterfeit too.

To knowingly keep or allow to be kept on relevant premises, goods such as cigarettes, which have been imported without payment of duty or which had otherwise been unlawfully imported is a criminal offence as per section 144 (1) and (3) of the Licensing Act 2003.

Trading Standards has "responsible authority" status under the Licensing Act 2003. K S Stores, has engaged in activities which have breached a licensing objective namely the prevention of crime and disorder. The Home Office publishes guidance under section 182 of the 2003 Act and at 11.27 that guidance advises that the sale of contraband or counterfeit tobacco is activity that should be considered "partcularly seriously." The guidance goes on to state that:

"Where reviews arise and the licensing authority determines that the crime prevention objective is being undermined through the premises being used to further crimes, it is expected that suspension or revocation of the licence — even in the first instance should be seriously considered."

Additionally the sale of illicit tobacco:

-contributes to the shadow ecomony

-undermines the City's public health activity which aims to deter residents from smoking especially young people

-drives down the cost of tobacco thereby counteracting Central Government's attempts to use price as a disincentive.




