The Committee is asked to note:

1. That the Director of Finance approved the Draft Statement of Accounts 2014/15 on 30 June 2015, as required by the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011.
2. That the 2014/15 Draft Statement of Accounts is to be audited by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP from July through to September, and that any material changes required as a result of the audit will be reported to the Audit Committee.
3. That formal approval by the council and publication of the 2014/15 Statement of Accounts is required by 30 September 2015 (Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011).
4. That the Statement of Accounts incorporates a copy of the Annual Governance Statement as required by the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011.

1.0 Purpose

- 1.1 The draft Statement of Accounts for 2014/15, which is subject to audit, has been approved by the Director of Finance and is appended to this report.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 The draft Statement of Accounts is required by statute (Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011) to be prepared and approved by the Section 151 Officer by 30 June 2015.
- 2.2 A copy of the draft Statement of Accounts is attached at Appendix A. This will now be audited by the council's appointed external auditors, PricewaterhouseCoopers, during August, following which they will report their findings to the Audit Committee in September. At the same time the final audited Statement of Accounts to be published by the council will be presented to the Committee for approval.
- 2.3 The statutory deadline for publication of the audited Statement of Accounts is 30 September 2015.
- 2.4 The format of the Statement of Accounts is governed by the Code of Practice on Local Authority Accounting (the Code), published by the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA). They are prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS). There were no significant changes to the Code for 2014/15.

3.0 Financial Implications

- 3.1 The statement, and the forthcoming audit of those statements by the external auditors, is an important element of the accountability and transparency of the council's finances.
