Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

Historic Permissions consistent with the Justices Licence as converted under the Licensing Act 2003

Provision of substantial refreshment

Hot food or hot drinks may be provided in line with alcohol sales with an additional thirty minutes thereafter.

Recorded Music

The playing of recorded music in the premises is permitted 24 hours a day pursuant to Section 182 of the Licensing Act 1964.

New Years Eve

The Regulatory Reform (Special Occasions Licensing) Order 2002.

- Where this licence does not otherwise permit, on New Years Eve these hours may be extended from the end of licensed hours on New Years Eve to the start of licensed hours on New Years Day.

Private Entertainment

The provision of private entertainment for private gain is permitted 24 hours a day pursuant to Section 2 (2)(b) of the Private Places of Entertainment (Licensing Act) 1967.

Sale of Alcohol to residents

These premises are entitled to sell alcohol to residents and supply their bona fide guests 24 hours a day pursuant to section 63(2) LA 1964.

Conditions consistent with Public Entertainment Licence

- All conditions that are specified on or consistent with the Public Entertainment Licence granted on 10 June 2005 under the Local Government Act 1982 will apply to all hours of regulated entertainment.
- The number of persons present at any public entertainment provided under this licence shall not at any time exceed:- 110

General

I have undertaken my own risk assessment to take the following proposed steps.

- The types of regulated entertainment proposed materially do no more than reinstate the normal pub entertainment that was previously unregulated;
- No new steps have been identified in relation to the four licensing objectives save as below

The prevention of crime and disorder

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below.

- No customers apparently carrying open bottles upon entry shall be admitted to the premises at any times the premises are open to the public
- Alcoholic and other drinks may not be removed from the premises in open containers save for consumption in any external area provided for that purpose
- The maximum occupancy of the building (including staff and performers) will be restricted to 110 persons

Public Safety

- No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed.
- To comply with the reasonable requirements of the fire officer from time to time
- To comply with the reasonable requirements of the building control officer

The prevention of public nuisance

- No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed.
- Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly
- Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties

The protection of children from harm

- The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply.
- No unusual or additional risks of harm to children have been identified
- No films or videos of any description will be shown so that they can be viewed by persons under the age of any applicable BBFC/Local Authority certification.

Conditions added after minor variation – 27/06/2014

- A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be installed and maintained at the premises.
- CCTV should cover entry and exit points of the premises and all areas where alcohol/money is served/taken and all areas for where public have access and the immediate vicinity outside the premises.
- Images/ recordings to be downloaded in a suitable format and provided to any member of a Responsible Authority upon request and without any undue delay.
- Images and recordings must be of evidential quality, must indicate the correct time and be kept for at least 30 days.
- All staff to be trained to use the CCTV system and at least one member of staff to be on duty who is trained to download the systems images should any member of a responsible authority make a request.
