Dear Anita,

I write on behalf of the Licensing Authority as a Responsible Authority to submit formal representations to the above new premises licence application.

There is a rebuttable presumption that applications within a C.I.Z will be refused unless the applicant can demonstrate that there will be no negative cumulative impact on one or more of the licensing objectives; Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Prevention of Public Nuisance, Protection of Children from Harm and Public Safety.

There is insufficient information within the operating schedule to demonstrate how the applicant will rebut the presumption of non-grant.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Protection of Children from Harm:-

The applicant has requested the sale/supply of alcohol on and off the premises, Monday to Sunday 10:00 to 03:00 hours. This raises concern for the Licensing Authority as the applicant has not indicated the intended use for the premises. This also applies to licensable activities, non-standard timings and the opening hours.

Within the operating schedule, the applicant has also requested alcohol off sales for the outdoor pavement area only – however this is adopted highway.

The plans submitted only show a bar. Is the intention of the premises to be a vertical drinking establishment?

Within the operating schedule, the applicant has stated that children under the age of 18 are allowed into the premises up to 2300 hours with a parent, guardian or a responsible adult on home games which starts at 19:45 or 20:00 hours.

It appears that the applicant has given no regard to the Statement of Licensing Policy regarding the [venue being within the City Centre Cumulative Impact Zone](#).

Therefore, further clarity is required within the operating schedule in order to address the above concerns. I will be looking to discuss the application further with the applicant prior to a Statutory Licensing Sub-Committee hearing.
