Thank-you for your email dated 22/09/2020 in reference to the request made by Purity Club for an alcohol license.

I have reviewed the documentation by the applicant and feel currently granting an alcohol license would undermine the licensing objectives but particularly;

- The prevention of crime and disorder

The application has some omissions in its operating schedule in relation to alcohol we would expect to see within the application, especially given the location and proximity to the City centre CIZ. In addition, the commissioned drugs and alcohol services are based nearby in Pitt Street.

The omissions include a refusals log and the CCTV recording being available for 30 days and for responsible authorities to view upon request.

We would be happy to mediate with the applicant prior to the hearing, and this may negate the need to for the hearing completely if an agreement can be reached providing there are no other representations from other responsible authorities or other parties.
