I write on behalf of Environmental Health as a Responsible Authority to submit formal representations in support of the review applied for by the Licensing Authority, as a Responsible Authority, due to the general failure to comply with conditions applied to the premises licence.

Following complaints made to Environmental Health, my colleague assisted Trading Standards in their visit to the premises in June 2019 where several illegal tobacco products were discovered on the premises and were subsequently seized. More information of this is detailed in the email dated 5.5.21, sent by Dianne Slack to support the premises licence review.

The premises licence holder and management have failed to uphold the licensing objective(s) of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Prevention of Public Nuisance, Public Safety and/or Protection of Children from Harm.
