




Annual Statement- Volumes of FOI and EIR have increased from 2020-2021, but are not back to the pre-pandemic levels the Council was dealing with. The Council continues to exceed the 90% target response rate set by the regulatory authority the ICO.








Annual Statement - The number of SARS received remained relatively similar to previous years. The number of disclosure requests received form other professional bodies (Police, other LAs) has increased by approx 100 more requests this year than last.

### **Information Incidents**





The volumes of incidents reported this year are comparable with the previous year, but are still reduced from those seen pre-pandemic levels. The largest category of breaches occuring continues to be emails sent to the wrong recipient. The Council is looking at Data Rights Management software with Digital & IT to address this. Two cases were of high enough risk to be reported to the ICO.
