We would like to complain about the alcohol and refreshment licence application for the above premises.

They are unsuitable for such use ;

The area is totally residential .The granting of such a licence would be extremely detrimental and disruptive for the area and residents.

The premises are very small and would only be suitable for up to 15 persons . The only toilets are situated in the adjoining hairdressers .

Most of the seating is outside

There is no room for live entertainment.

The people who would be attracted to such a venue would be revellers on their way home who élite the buses and taxis in the area. These people many of whom are intoxicated currently make their way home straight off the transport.

Many of the houses are only 30 metres away. (Including ours)

When the premises operated as a pub prior to the alterations a couple of years ago, the permissions that were in force were those of a normal Public House ie, 11pm closing

The noise of the music, revellers, and vehicles would be totally out of order for a residential area

There is no such requirement for this sort of establishment by the local community
