Dear Licensing,

I write on behalf of the Licensing Authority as a Responsible Authority to submit formal representations to the above application under the licensing objective(s) of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Prevention of Public Nuisance, Public Safety or Protection of Children from Harm.

The plan doesn't suitably explain the layout of the premises and licensable activities.

The premises is located within (a Special Consideration Area as the premises is located within a close proximity to) the City Centre [Cumulative Impact Zone](#) (CIZ). There is a rebuttable presumption that applications within a C.I.Z will be refused unless the applicant can demonstrate that there will be no negative cumulative impact on one or more of the licensing objectives; Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Prevention of Public Nuisance, Protection of Children from Harm and Public Safety. The Matrix Approach outlined on Page 40 of the 'Statement of Licensing Policy' suggests operating times for specific venue types.

There is insufficient information within the operating schedule to show how the applicant will address these licensing objectives.

I will be looking to mediate with the applicant in order to address these concerns by way of amendments to the operating schedule prior to a Statutory Licensing Sub-Committee hearing.
