Dear Licensing,

I write on behalf of Public Health as a Responsible Authority to submit supporting formal representations to the above application under the licensing objectives of The Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Protection of Children from Harm.

Public Health have very serious concerns regarding the sales of illicit tobacco, illicit vapes and underage sales. This is further exacerbated by the fact that there was no statutory licence summary on display and the tobacco gantry was openly displaying tobacco products.

The premises not upholding the licensing objectives and failure to comply with the conditions attached the licensing agreement.

As a Responsible Authority we would expect any business licensed to sell age restricted items, to act responsibly at all times and promote the key objectives of the Licensing Act 2003.

Public Health is not reassured that the business is operating in adherence to the Licensing Act and therefore supports Licensing Authorities request to review the current licence. I, or a suitable representative from Public Health, will be available to attend the hearing and provide further information as required.
