Public Health would like to make representations to this application under the public safety licensing objective. Whilst I cannot evidence issues from this specific premise I believe increasing the supply and availability of alcohol 24 hours a day in an area that is already experiencing problems with alcohol misuse is irresponsible and will only further add to the increasing levels of hazardous and harmful drinking the city currently experiences.

I understand the applicant is currently liaising with several of the responsible authorities and that a licensing sub-committee hearing is planned for 6th August. I will not be able to attend the hearing due to leave but Public Health would support a reduction in the sale of alcohol hours should the premises licence be granted by the committee.
