NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the City of Wolverhampton Council, being the Local Authority for the area, intends to make prescribed alterations to the following community school with effect from 1 January 2018:

Springdale Junior School, Warstones Drive, Penn, Wolverhampton, WV4 4NJ The prescribed alterations are to:

- lower the age range of Springdale Junior School from 7-11 years to 3-11 years
- enlarge the school premises of Springdale Junior School to accommodate infant pupils.
