**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the City of Wolverhampton Council, being the Local Authority for the area, intends to make prescribed alterations to the following community school with effect from 1 September 2018:

Whitgreave Junior School, Goodyear Avenue, Low Hill, Wolverhampton, WV10 9JP

The prescribed alterations are to:

- lower the age range of Whitgreave Junior School from 7-11 years to 3-11 years
- enlarge the school premises of Whitgreave Junior School to accommodate infant pupils.
