By changing the designation to include pupils with ASD, SLD and PMLD and by increasing numbers of roll, Penn Hall will become a large generic special school. This is going against national research which suggests that these types of schools are not effective due to the huge spread of needs and abilities - staff training requirements are huge. Costs to adapt the building (which is a listed building) would be huge and long term not sustainable. Some of our present leavers have been directed to Penn Hall with dire results. Parents have identified a large number of issues - accommodation is not suitable, safety of the site, play facilities, learning resources, staff expertise is lacking, peer groups are not compatible. There is a need to open a free special school - CLPT have identified land, have a letter of support from the RSC and just need a letter from the LA to state how many places they would commission. There is obviously a need to create more places. It would be more cost effective to build a free school on the opposite side of the city to Broadmeadow - a sister school. We have the expertise in early years, ASD, SLD, PMLD and SEMH. We are a designated Teaching School and a National Support School. We have been rated outstanding by Ofsted since 2010. We are highly regarded by parents and professionals across the city. Our pupils make outstanding progress and we offer range of specialist teaching techniques. The cost to the LA would be a lot less - place funding and capital build and maintenance would be via the DfE, with just the high needs funding coming via the LA. These pupils will have to be funded regardless of where they receive their education.

While I agree with both proposals there are significant ramifications of these, particularly the increase in number on roll. 24 additional pupils will need to be transported to school. Already the car park and playground are full at the start and end of the day with the buses needed to provide transport for our pupils. 24 additional pupils will mean four or five extra buses and there does not seem space for them. 24 additional pupils will occupy a lot of space so demand on resources will increase. Our dinner hall is full at lunch time; where will the children eat? Our hall is full at assembly time; where will the children sit? Classrooms, rebound therapy room, swimming pool, etc. I fear the current pupils will lose out unless additional facilities are provided. Penn Hall School has been an outstanding school for years and provides a fantastic education for its pupils. Pupils have access to brilliant facilities but to increase the number by 24 will mean they can access these facilities less often as they will have to be shared among more pupils. Expansion is exciting but needs appropriate funding/building to meet the needs of the growing population.

As with our own experience of knowing many of the Penntall students, some are very 'delicate' and easily startled & upset by unexpected noise / actions, therefore the potential of making it a distressing environment for them to be in.

A Careful Consideration, therefore, should be taken for the welfare of the pupils already within the school & whether the new children taken on, are in the appropriate school.

Expanding Pupil numbers may be more cost effective for the LEA but as long as this doesn't impact on the quality and lovely feel of the school and also that the student/teacher ratio is not impacted either. It would be a tragedy for these issues, if not carefully considered, badly affecting our school.
