The Council is recommended to:

1. Approve the protocol for awarding Freedom of the City.

1.0 Purpose

1.1 This report proposes the adoption of a protocol which will clarify the nomination process and the way in which the Freedom of the City will be awarded in future. There are presently no guidelines or protocols governing the way in which the Council makes such awards.

- 2.1 On 9 July 2021, Governance and Ethics Committee name considered a report on Awarding Freedom of the City.
- 2.2 Copies of the report have been supplied to Councillors and can also be accessed online on the Council's website here.
- 2.3 Governance and Ethics Committee recommended to Council that it approves:
 - 1. Approve the protocol for awarding Freedom of the City.

3.0 Nomination Process

- 3.1 Nominations for persons or organisations to be granted Freedom of the City, may be made by any serving Councillor of the Council to the Director of Governance on the appropriate form (see Appendix 1).
- 3.2 Each nomination must contain the support of at least 10 Councillors of the Council and where appropriate, the Councillor should first raise the matter for discussion within their political group.
- 3.3 The Director of Governance will check that sufficient information has been provided on the form and will then pass the nomination to the Group Leaders for consideration.
- 3.4 The Group Leaders and the Mayor will meet to consider the nomination against the criteria. Following unanimous agreement, a report will be prepared for Governance and Ethics Committee recommending the convening of a special meeting of the Council on a date to be determined to approve the conferment of the title.
- 3.5 Once the recommendation has been approved, a special meeting of the Council will be held normally on a date following the meeting of the Governance and Ethics Committee and immediately prior to the next ordinary meeting of the Council (i.e. on the same day, approximately 15 minutes beforehand).
- 3.6 Alternatively, they may decide that the nomination is not suitable as it does not meet the criteria. Where a nomination is not agreed, the reasons for not progressing the nomination will be provided by the Director of Governance to the nominating councillors. In such circumstances, further nominations for an individual will not be considered for a further twelve months.
