Several members of the regular street drinkers can be seen with cans of alcohol on them before the incident takes place. The store owner explained that the man was frequently attempting to purchase alcohol from his store whilst clearly intoxicated and often becomes argumentative and verbally abusive, we recommended he ban the individual and said we'd be looking at further preventative measures such as CPWs to potentially ban the individual from the street. I advised the market staff to use their body cameras and to record all interactions with the drinkers. If the drinkers refuse or are aggressive then to call the police.

The security started now they open the gates by the benches they are becoming a problem again as customers are too intimidated to use these areas when it is full of street drinkers.

Ambo is not needed nor wanted. This male presents as just drunk, causing no issues.

16:40 hours on 27/05/2021 PCSO Millar 31364 and PCSO Bradley 31697 were on patrol in Cleveland Street. There was a large group of known drinkers around the bench area outside the market. There was no visible alcohol being consumed so I went to the the wulfrun security office to speak to staff and see if there had been any issues today.

Security turned the CCTV onto the group, there were two unknown females approx late teens, early 20's sat on their own on two of the seats. They were not part of the group and minding their own business, an unknown IC3 male who has been seen with the drinkers before in Cleveland street sits on the floor near to them. [REDACTED] then walks over and throws a can on the floor and starts an argument with the unknown IC3 male. [REDACTED] then walks over and says something to the females and the two females walk off away from the group. The CCTV suggests the females seem to walk away due to the behaviour of the drinkers.

When [REDACTED] threw the can I called up on the police radio for officers to attend so we could speak to the group and prevent any disorder.

Whilst viewing the CCTV I also observed [REDACTED] drinking from a black can. I directed PC Bevan 5192 to the area who recovered the black can that [REDACTED] was drinking from.

The can was Okocim Beer and a 500ml, 6.5% can.

This is a breach of [REDACTED] CPW.

The CCTV from wulfrun in relation to this incident has been recorded on my mobility device and uploaded to evidence.com.

PC Jacob Blunt 23743 spoke to [REDACTED] who was one of the group and [REDACTED] surrendered 1 x can of open cider.

Myself PCSO Millar 31364 also attended, there was an open can of cider on the floor but we could not confirm who had been drinking this. I spoke to [REDACTED] to advise him and this is not the first incident over the last week.

On the 15/05/2021 there was a protest in wolverhampton city centre and Sgt Yeomans 4950 stated that [REDACTED] was in and around the area shouting and being a general nuisance and believed to be under the influence of alcohol.

On the same date 15/05/2021 at 15:42 I PCSO Millar spoke to [REDACTED] who was arguing and shouting next to the market on cleveland street. He had an open can of alcohol on this occasion also and was advised on his behaviour. I informed [REDACTED] on both occasions that wolverhampton city centre is an alcohol free area and that he is liable to get a fine which he said he would not pay.

On 17/05/2021 I explained to [REDACTED] that because there had been three alcohol related incidents now with [REDACTED] in the city centre over the last week I would be preparing a CPW. I have prepared this ready to be served.

I asked [REDACTED] if he wanted help with his alcohol addiction and he said no because he is already getting help from recovery near you. He also stated that he is living at his moms address in ashmore park but did not confirm number or street.

[REDACTED] had a open can of blackstorm cider in his coat pocket which was surrendered to PC bradley 7232 and disposed of. He was sat on the benches on cleveland street next to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was also sat on the benches next to [REDACTED] and had an open can of blackstorm cider on his lap. PCSO 30179 disposed of the can after it was surrendered.

Myself PCSO Millar 31364 attended and spoke to [REDACTED] I advised them both that they cant drink alcohol in the street in Wolverhampton city centre and that we have had previous reports in relation to anti-social behaviour in this area from the same group of individuals.

There were no complaints or calls on this occasion. This was proactive work from city centre team 1 to prevent any disorder or anti-social behaviour.
