THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE issued by West Midlands Police, pursuant to section 43 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014

West Midlands Police are satisfied that your conduct is having a detrimental effect on the quality of life of others in the locality of:

The City of Wolverhampton in so far as

You cause nuisance, annoyance, harassment, alarm and distress to members of the public through persistent alcohol consumption in an alcohol free area which in turn causes Anti-Social Behavior. This:

- Is having a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality
- · Is persistent or continuing in nature; and
- Is Unreasonable.

Note that "conduct" in this instance is defined as including a failure to act, in this case to deal with:

- Repeatedly consuming alcohol in an alcohol free area and causing harassment alarm and distress to members of the public, businesses and visitors to Wolverhampton. Being in an intoxicated state thereby causing Harassment, Alarm and distress to members of the public and visitors to the city of Wolverhampton.
- * "Conduct" on, or affecting, premises that a person owns, leases, occupies, controls, operates, or maintains, is treated as conduct of that person.

AND THIS NOTICE NOW REQUIRES THAT YOU UNDERTAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTION TO REMEDY THE NUISANCE

- 1) Not to behave in any way causing or likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to any person in the City Centre of Wolverhampton as defined by map 1 (see areas included below)
- 2) Not to consume alcohol in any public place other than a licensed premises in the City Centre of Wolverhampton as defined by map 1 (see areas included below)
- 3) Not to be in possession of an open container of alcohol in any public place other than in a licensed premises in the City Centre of Wolverhampton as defined by map 1 (see areas included below)
- 4) Not to be in an intoxicated state in any public place, be it through alcohol, psychoactive substances, or any other controlled substances in the City of Wolverhampton as defined by map 2 (see areas included below)

Map 1 – relates to Wolverhampton City Centre as defined by the ring road. This includes St Johns Retail Park and adjoining car park, Sainsburys St Marks Chapel Ash, Asda Supermarket Jack Hayward Way and The Molinuex Football Stadium.

Map 2 - relates to the "City of Wolverhampton" which means the areas of Oxley, Bushbury North, Low Hill, The Scotlands, Wednesfield, Fallings park, Heathfield park, Whitmore Reans, Tettenhall, Bantock, Penn, Merryhill, Blakenhall, Ettingshall, Bilston East, Bilston North, East Park, Springvale and the City Centre.

WARNING

If you fail without reasonable excuse to comply with the requirement(s) of this Notice:

- i. You may be prosecuted. If you are prosecuted and convicted the maximum penalty for an individual is a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale (currently £2500) and unlimited in the case of a body;
- ii. You may, in the alternative, be given the opportunity of accepting in lieu of prosecution a fixed penalty, in the amount of £80.

In addition to the above, the local authority may enter any of your land in the open air without a Court order to remedy the problem and charge you for the costs incurred.

The Court may also order works to be carried out and / or seizure / forfeiture of relevant items.

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

An appeal against this notice may be made to a magistrates' court within 21 days from the date on which it is served, on the grounds that:

- I. The conduct specified in the community protection notice
 - a. did not take place,
 - b. has not had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality,
 - c. has not been of a persistent or continuing nature,
 - d. is not unreasonable, or
 - e. is conduct that the person cannot reasonably be expected to control or affect.
- II. Any of the requirements in the notice, or any of the periods within which or times by which they are to be complied with, are unreasonable.
- III. There is a material defect or error in, or in connection with, the notice.
- IV. The notice was issued to the wrong person.




