1.1 For the Cabinet Members to respond to the questions received:

a. Victoria Street

Councillor Simon Bennett to ask the Cabinet Member for City Environment and Climate Change:

When will the roadworks in Victoria Street be finished?

b. Westside

Councillor Wendy Thompson to ask the Deputy Leader: Inclusive City Economy:

What plans are in place for the site previously known as Westside?

c. PACT Meetings

Councillor Jonathan Crofts to ask the Cabinet Member for Health and Wellbeing:

How and when will the Council inform the police and residents of all future dates and venues for PACT meetings over the coming year?

d. Care Packages

Councillor Paul Singh to ask the Cabinet Member for Adults:

Can the portfolio holder please give further information on which other authorities have patients in Wolverhampton that require care packages and have been waiting over four weeks for their authorities to find them continued care?

e. Road Resurfacing

Councillor Andrew Randle to ask the Cabinet Member for City Environment and Climate Change:

Can the Council commit to resurfacing essential and well used roads in the city, particularly Amos Lane in Wednesfield, which require attention?

f. West Midlands Police and Crime Panel

g. Council Assets
